Item No.1 : Levy of tax on sale Chhangphut sahbawn under Mizoram Valued Added Tax Act,2005. -Taxation Deptt.

Approved the proposal to the levy tax on sale of Chhangphut Sahbawn @ 4% under the Mizoram Value Added Tax Act, 2005.

Item No.2 : Proposal for amendment to clause 7.A.(4) & (5) of the Mizoram Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme, 2009. -RD Deptt

Approved the proposal for amendment of Rule 7.A(4) and Rule 7.A(5) of the Mizoram Rural Employment Guarantee (Amendment) Scheme, 2009.

Item No.3 : Proposal for Amendment of the Mizoram Grievance Redressal Rules, 2009. -RD Deptt.

Approved the draft Mizoram Grievance Redressal (Amendment) Rules, 2010 inserting new sub-rules 5(d), 7(12), 7(13), and new rule '8-A' after Rule 8, and new rule '9-A' after Rule 9.

Item No. 6 : Proposal for Levying Stamp duty on payment of salaries under the Govt. of Mizoram. -FD(FEA)

Approved the proposal for levying Stamp Duty on Monthly payment of all regular Govt. Officials including Council of Ministers, Parliamentary Secretaries etc. and on all bills in respect of payment made by various Deptts. and offices to private parties at the following rates :-

Item No.12 : Proposal for establishment of Office of Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities. -SWD

Approved the proposals as follows:-

- 1) Establishment of Office of Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities to be headed by the Commissioner;
- 2) Creation of a post of Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities in the Pay Band of PB-4 plus Grade Pay i.e., Rs. 37,400 – 67,000 + Rs.9,500/-;
- 3) Filling up of the eleven (11) posts already created for the office of the Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities as follows:-

4) Hiring of private building for accommodation of office of the Commissioner of Persons with Disabilities in the event that accommodation is not available in any of the old Secretariat Building at Treasury Square, Aizawl.

Item No.14 : Amended of the Mizoram (Regulation and Control of Vehicle Parking) Rules, 2010. -Transport Deptt.

Approved the draft Mizoram (Regulation and Control of Vehicle Parking)(Amendment) Rules, 2010 amending Rule 11 and Rule 12 of the Mizoram (Regulation and Control of Vehicle Parking) Rules, 2000.

Item No.15 : Amendment of Aizawl Development Authority Act, 2005. -UD&PA Deptt.

Approved the Aizawl Development Authority (Amendment) Bill, 2010 amending sub-sections (1),(2),(3) and (4) of Section 21 of the Aizawl Development Authority Act, 2005.

Item no.16 : The Mizoram Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Bill, 2010. -UD&PA Deptt.

Deferred.

Item No.18 : New Secretariat Complex-a Baptist Kohhran Biak In hmun ruhman chungchang. -GAD

Deferred.

Item No.19 : Autonomous Council District hnuai Deficit middle Schools chungchang. -School Edn. Deptt.

Approved the proposal for provincialisation of 44 (forty-four) Middle Schools under two Autonomous District Councils viz. 18 (eighteen) Middle Schools under the Lai Autonomous District Council and (26 (twenty-six) Middle Schools under the Mara Autonomous District Council **subject to** the condition that all pension liabilities shall be borne by the respective Autonomous District Councils as already committed by them in writing.

Item No.20 : Creation of one post of Superintendent of Taxes to function as Assistant Registrar of Firms and Societies and one post of UDC. -Taxation Deptt.

Approved in principle for the next financial year subject to improvement of state financial position.

Item No.21 : Model Piggery Village thiah chungchang. -AH&Vety Deptt.

Approved. All the beneficiaries should leave the respective Model Piggery Village within 6 (six) months.

- 1) Kawlkulh Model piggery Village – the land shall be placed under the custody of the Village Council for construction of residential houses for the economically deprived/weaker section of the society.
- 2) Model Piggery Village, Pukpui & Sairang – the residents may remove the materials of the buildings in which they are living, but the entire area of the land shall be transferred to the Government in the Land Revenue & Settlement Deptt to be kept as Reserved Land Bank.

Item No.23 : Collection of Toll on Indo-Myanmar Border Bridge Rules, 2010. -Trade & Commerce Deptt.

1. **Approved** the draft rules.
2. The Trade & Commerce Deptt. may explore possibility of setting up toll gate at Kanhmun for vehicles coming from Tripura and Assam.
3. Both Trade & Commerce and LR&S Departments may earmark/demarcate some portion of the Zokhawthar Border Trade area for the exclusive use of the Mizoram Government.

Item No.24 : The Mizoram Excise & Narcotics (Wine)(Amendment) Rules, 2010. -Exc.&Nar. Deptt.

Approved the draft Mizoram Excise & Narcotics (Wine) (Amendment) Rules, 2010 inserting new sub-rules (12) and (13) in Rule 5 of the Mizoram Excise & Narcotics (Wine) Rules, 2008.

Additional Items:

Item No.1 : The Draft Mizoram Board of School Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 2010. -School Edn. Deptt.

Approved the Mizoram Board of School Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 2010 to amend Section 2 and Section 11 of the MBSE Act, 1975 as amended from time to time.

Item No.2 : The Aizawl Municipal Council (Facilities to Chairman, Vice Chairman, Executive Councilors and Councilors) Rules, 2010. -UD&PA

Approved with modifications that Rule 9(8) shall be deleted and Rule 9(9) of the draft Rules shall be numbered Rule 9(8).

Item No.3 : The Mizoram Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2010. -FCS&CA Deptt.

Approved.

Item No.4 : Sialkal Range Development Council din rawtna. -GAD

Taken up and left for reconsideration and decision in the next year. In the meantime, the leaders of the locality/leaders actually living in Sialkal range shall be called to meet the Chief Minister.

Item No.5 : Rules/Guidelines for Recognition as approved Tour Operator. -Tourism Deptt.

Approved the draft Mizoram Recognition of Tour Operator Rules, 2010.

Item No.6 : Establishment of Medical College in Mizoram. –H&FW Deptt.

Early setting up of a Medical College in Mizoram is approved.

Item No. 7 : Grant of Special Incentive/Allowances to Police Personnels on Deputation to the Anti Corruption Bureau. - FD (PRU)

Approved the proposal to lower the rate of Special Incentive / Allowances to Police personnels on deputation to the Anti Corruption Bureau from 30% to 15% of basic pay.
